Costs of scouting:

- Joiner fee: \$35 (includes Boy's Life magazine subscription, membership dues, and other program costs).
- Uniform: \$23(blue Cub Scout shirt)
\$22(blue Cub Scout shorts)
\$9(Cub Scout web belt)
\$5(Cub Scout socks)
\$12(Cub Scout hat)
\$3(neckerchief slide)
\$4(unit numbers)
\$5(Council shoulder patch)
- Uniform Total: \$83(approximate cost plus tax per scoutstuff.org website)
- Activities and extras: Nominal fee for family camping, field trips, parties, awards and Pinewood Derby.
- Fundraising: Fundraising helps to keep our costs down and provide a fun, exciting program. Each year pack 22 participates in two fund raising events: national popcorn sales and one pack fund raiser to be determined. Fund raising money earned help to offset program costs. Each family is expected to participate in our fundraising efforts to help with the whole program.
- Council camps: Cost vary per camp — approximately \$50 per scout.

Cub Scouting Basics
